





Dress Code (Version: 02.11.15)

The following 'Dress Code' applies to ALL Students and ALL Staff & Governors at Marland School.

STUDENTS

All clothing / footwear must:

- look presentable
- be safe (no dangerous parts, i.e. steel toecaps, etc.)
- be clean
- fit well
- be age appropriate
- be appropriately functional for the weather / season
- be appropriate for the time of day (*i.e. no pyjamas* / 'onesies' / nightwear / slippers to be worn around school during the school day, etc.)

Clothing / footwear **MUST NOT**:

- be revealing / indecent / have any potential sexual connotations (whether intentional or not)
- display inappropriate pictures / logos / messages (*i.e. drugs, extremist viewpoints, sexual comments, swear words, etc.*)
- be unsafe

STAFF & GOVERNORS

<u>In addition</u> to the 'Students' list above, Staff & Governors are also expected to adhere to the national standard dress codes and norms that would usually be applied to the various professional roles that they undertake, e.g.

- T&L staff dress in a smart professional manner appropriate to the lessons being delivered
- RCW staff in a more casual manner more suited to a 'homely' pastoral environment
- Support & other staff in accordance with the requirements of their respective duties
